Dear Colleagues,

The Journal *Annals of the University of Craiova, series Psychology-Pedagogy* (ISSN 1582-313X), published by the Teacher Training Department through the Psychopedagogy Research Center (Romanian acronym CCPP) proposes you as theme for no. 2/2018 *Educational communication - psycho-pedagogical, social and linguistic configurations*.

The importance that communication has in our life and work is unanimously acknowledged, regardless of context, situation, interlocutor. In the didactic, educational context, it is an essential condition for the success of both the teacher and the pupils / students. The communicative competence is considered to be transversal, and can be formed and, at the same time, practised, and put to good use beyond the boundaries of an educational subject.

The relevance of the theme is also rendered by its complexity, the multiple approaching perspectives, from the linguistic ones to the psychological, pedagogical, sociological, either separately or from a transversal or integrated approach.

Your articles may represent theoretical and / or praxiological approaches in an attempt to clarify, develop, optimize, in an original manner, the important aspects concerning the educational communication or the didactic and / or managerial communication in terms of forms, dimensions of the educational competence.

The sections recommended for this number are:

1. The psychological dimension of educational communication
2. Didactic communication in the context of the school reality of the moment (external, non-discursive characteristics, linguistic forms of realization, content, programs, organizational forms, evaluation and certification etc.)
3. Socio-educational communication in the context of the social life (strategies, types of learning, target audience)
4. Communication competence
5. Ways to optimize the teacher's communication with the class of students / student group
6. Managerial communication - the essential dimension of successful management

The assessment of the studies will take into account the following aspects: the perspective of the research; the novelty of the issue approached and its theoretical substantiation; the design of the research; the methodology of the research; the results obtained; the consistency and relevance of the discussions and of the interpretations; the consistency of the conclusions; the relevance and timeliness of the bibliography.

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Technical details

Paper length: 10 - 15 pages, in MS Word; reviews, conference reports, reading notes: 2-4 pages.

We accept only papers in English or French. The papers will be evaluated by 2 independent reviewers, in the blind Peer-Review system. An author can contribute **up to two papers**, provided they fit into different sections of the volume. We only accept studies where **the maximum number of authors is 2**. In this case, the contact author shall be indicated.

Text formatting - top: 2 cm, bottom: 2 cm, left: 2 cm, right: 2 cm, heading: 2 cm, footing: 0 cm, page size: B5 (17 cm x 24 cm), Times New Roman, 11 pt, spacing - single 1 (please see the Annex). Citations of bibliography and webography shall be done in accordance the APA Publication Manual (American Psychological Association), the 6th edition.

An Abstract of maximum 250 words and 3-5 key words shall be provided alongside the paper.
