Paper length: **10 - 15 pages**, in MS Word; reviews, conference reports, reading notes: 2-4 pages.

**The texts shall be fully written in English or French. The texts in French will be accompanied by the title, the abstract, the key words and the institutional affiliation of the author(s) in English.**

The papers will be evaluated by 2 independent reviewers in the blind Peer-Review system. An author can contribute **up to two papers**, provided they fit into different sections of the volume. We

only accept papers where **the maximum number of authors is 3**. In this case, the contact author shall be indicated.

**Text formatting** - top: 2 cm, bottom: 2 cm, left: 2 cm, right: 2 cm, heading: 2 cm, footing: 0 cm, page size: B5 (17 cm x 24 cm), Times New Roman, 11 pt, spacing - single 1 (please see the Annex). Citations of bibliography and webography shall be done in accordance the APA Publication Manual (American Psychological Association), the 6<sup>th</sup> edition.

An Abstract of maximum 250 words and 3-5 key words (**in English**) shall be provided alongside the paper.
