We would like to invite you to submit your articles for publication in issue 45(1) of 2023, in *the Annals of the University of Craiova, Psychology-Pedagogy Series* (ISSN 2668-6678, ISSN-L 1582-313X), published by the Teacher Training Department, University of Craiova, through the Centre for Psychopedagogical Research (romanian acronym CCPP).

The evaluation of the articles, carried out in a blind Peer-Review system, will take into account the following aspects: the research perspective; the novelty of the addressed approach and the way of its theoretical substantiation; the research design; the research methodology; the

obtained results; the relevance of discussions and interpretations; the consistency of conclusions; the relevance and topicality of the bibliography.

Publication requirements:

Paper length: **10 - 15 pages**, in MS Word; reviews, conference reports, reading notes: 2-4 pages.

The studies should be fully written in English or French, with an abstract of maximum 250 words and 3-5 key words. The studies in French will be accompanied, at the beginning, by the title, the abstract, the key words and the institutional affiliation of the author(s) in English.

The papers will be evaluated by 2 independent reviewers in the blind Peer-Review system. An author can contribute **up to two papers**. We only accept papers where **the maximum number of authors is 3**. In this case, the contact author shall be indicated.

Text formatting - top: 2 cm, bottom: 2 cm, left: 2 cm, right: 2 cm, heading: 2 cm, footing: 0 cm, page size: B5 (17 cm x 24 cm), Times New Roman, 11 pt, spacing - single 1 (please see the Annex). Citations of bibliography and webography shall be done in accordance the APA Publication Manual (American Psychological Association), the 6th edition.
