Publication requirements:

The submitted manuscript should be between 10 and 15 pages, consistent with the editing requirements in MS Word.

The studies should be fully written in English or French, with an abstract of maximum 250 words and 3-5 key words. The studies in French will be accompanied, at the beginning, by the title, the abstract, the key words and the institutional affiliation of the author(s) in English.

The papers will be evaluated by 2 independent reviewers in the blind Peer-Review system. An author can contribute **up to two papers**. We only accept papers where **the maximum number of authors is 3**. In this case, the contact author shall be indicated. **The ORCID code will be specified for each author.**

Text formatting - top: 2 cm, bottom: 2 cm, left: 2 cm, right: 2 cm, heading: 2 cm, footing: 0 cm, page size: B5 (17 cm x 24 cm), Times New Roman, 11 pt, spacing - single 1 (please see the Annex). Citations of bibliography and webography shall be done in accordance the APA Publication Manual (American Psychological Association), the 7th edition. A great asset in your approach: the presentation and use of bibliographic resources: at least 15 in number (without taking into account self-citation), which have appeared especially in the last five years, these resources must be used to support the ideas of the study.

The manuscripts are evaluated by two independent reviewers, in a blind peer-review system research hypotheses addressed and the theoretical framework; research design; research methodology; the results obtained; relevance of discussions and interpretations; consistency of conclusions; the relevance and contemporaneity of the bibliography.
